Proclaim a holy fast!

Call an assembly!

Gather the elders,

all who dwell in the land,

To the house of the LORD, your God,

and cry out to the LORD! Joel 1:14



Guide for Fasting!

As we approach Lent, it is essential to reflect on how to prepare for a fast.

Before the fast (Try to prepare days in advance):

- 1. Ask the Lord if the fast is something you should do.
- 2. Offer the fast for special intentions.

- 3. Ask the Lord what specific areas of your life require change for the best or where prayers are needed in your life.
- 4. Pray for the grace to remain faithful till the end of the fast.
- 5. Inform your family for accountability (do not tell the world).
- 6. Encourage others to join you.
- 7. Try only to keep the food you should eat in your food pantry to avoid temptation.
- 8. Decrease the amount of food you usually eat before the fast.
- 9. If you have any medical condition, consult your doctor before fasting.



During the fast:

- 1. Pray daily/Pray in the Spirit/Stay in a spirit of prayer at all times, even if you are working.
- 2. Meditate and reflect on scriptures daily.
- 3. When you are hungry and tired, ask God to help you. Read the Psalms, listen to Praise and Worship music, or ask a friend or family to pray with you.
- 4. Adequate Rest and sleep are recommended.
- 5. Take time for silence and let God fill and love you.
- 6. Take a short prayer walk/moderate exercise.
- 7. If you feel ill, dizzy, lightheaded, or shaky, eat something from your fasting regimen.
- 8. Drink adequate water (if your fast permits).
- 9. Avoid alcohol, caffeine, and snacking.
- 10. Avoid entertainment.
- 10. Before eating for the day, thank God for the opportunity to fast, pray, and bless the meal.



After the Fast:

- 1. Praise and thank God for the fast.
- 2. Resume eating slowly and in small portions. Do not overindulge after the fast.
- 3. Ask God to guide you to regular fasting habits or if you must fast a little longer.
